Athlete Medical Service

Medical service will be available 24 hours a day during the stay of the teams in our city, this will be available in training and competition facilities as well as in the athletes official hotel. Lifeguards wil also be onsite at the competition venue during training and competition.

Divers and Team Officials Seating

Those divers that are competing in the event taking place will only be allowed on poolside. An area on the pool deck will also be provided for divers and team officials.

Event Information Desk

Event information desk will be placed on the lobby of the administration building of the High Performance Sports Center of Baja California.

Accreditation/ Accreditation Desk

Accreditation desk will be installed at the lobby offical hotel .All participants (divers, officials, representatives, etc.) **must send a passport size photo in .jpg format** to be used for the accreditation to the OC to the email (clavados@fmn.org.mx) before April 1st. 2012.













Rules

The FINA/Midea Diving World Series will be conducted under FINA rules.

Judges

Scoring: For the individual competitions, scoring will be in accordance with FINA Diving Rules D7.5 and D7.7. For the synchronized competitions there shall be 7 judges, comprising 2 execution judges and 5 synchronization judges. The secretaries shall accept the "execution awards" and shall cancel the highest and lowest "synchronization awards" and shall then calculate the score in accordance with FINA Diving Rule D7.7.

Prize Money

Each Event: The HMF/OC shall provide and pay prize money to a total of US\$ 96'000 at each Event to be divided between all of the 8 individual and synchro events, as follows:

1st. Place	US \$ 5,000.00	
2nd. Place	US \$ 4,000.00	
3rd. Place	US \$ 3,000.00	
Sub-Total	US \$12,'000.00	
Total x 8 events	US \$ 96,000.00	

Overall: The HMF/OC shall pay US\$ 50'000 annually to FINA for each year of the DWS 2010-2013 to be put towards the overall prize money. The overall annual prize money shall be US\$192'000 to be divided between all of the 8 individual and synchro events, as follows:

1st. Place	US \$ 10,000.00	
2nd. Place	US \$ 8,000.00	
3rd. Place	US \$ 6,000.00	
Sub-Total	US \$24,000.00	
Total x 8 events	US \$ 192,000.00
