Venue and Facilities

Venue Information

Built at an estimated cost of AED 1.1 billion (US \$300m.), the aim was to create a state-of-the-art venue that would put Dubai and the United Arab Emirates on the map as a location for aquatics, and that is exactly what has been achieved.

Covering 61 acres of land and located on the Dubai Bypass Road, the complex is the largest sporting facility in the city and has seating for 15,000 spectators. It boasts two 50-metre pools, both with moveable floors to allow conversion to 25-metre pools, catering for long or short course events, as well as a diving pool. In a city already full of superlatives, the building's striking architecture will ensure global recognition of the venue as a memorable and iconic facility in Dubai not only for Olympic standard swimming and diving events but also as a truly world class multi-sports arena.

The completion of the venue, which also boasts fifteen hospitality boxes, six hospitality suites, the Royal Box, a Ladies' Box, a 60-seater media conference room and a media centre with space for 194 journalists, is a source of great satisfaction to the Dubai Municipality and the Dubai Sports Council.

The venue is all about details – whether they are big or small. From the padded leather seats for each spectator, to changing facilitates for 400 athletes and the giant octagonal scoreboard and video screen that sits high above the competition pool, everyone is catered for. The uncompromisingly modern architecture of the building is functional as well as being elegant and striking. Its form and elevation treatment integrates flowing themes of the movement of water. The energy of dynamic and theatrical lighting will complement the drama of the building, especially by night.











The pool is equipped with high-tech moveable floors and walls which enable it to be subdivided into a number of different configurations to maximize its flexibility.

Athlete Medical Services

First aid will be available at the competition venue during training and competition for divers.

Lifeguards will be on-site at the competition venue to provide first aid during training and competition. A doctor will be onsite at the venue during competition times to provide medical treatment.

Ice will be available at the competition venue for the treatment of injuries.

Diver and Team Officials Seating

Those divers that are competing in the event taking place will only be allowed on poolside. An area on the pool deck will also be provided for divers and team officials.

Sport Information Desk

A Sport Information Desk will operate at the competition venue on the days of competition, as well as during any scheduled training sessions.

NOTE: All the withdrawal and correction forms must first be approved by the referee and then handed to the Secreteriat of the Competition.

Accreditation

Accreditation is an integral component of both the success and security of the FINA/MIDEA Diving World Series. It provides participants with access and entitlements to ensure that only those who are eligible have access to venues and restricted zones.

Access to all competition areas will be controlled at the venue perimeter and at the entrances to the various restricted zones within the venue in order to maintain security.











Teams will receive their accreditation on their arrival at the Hamdan Bin Mohammed Bin Rashid Sports Complex. All application for accreditation must have be submitted to mail@uaeswimming.com no later than the 25th of February 2012. The Accreditation forms can be found at the end of the Competition Information Package.

The Accreditation Desk will be located in the main foyer of the pool and will be open from Wednesday 13th of March. Please collect your accreditations from here.

If photos are not submitted prior to the event, then you will need to bring a passport sized photo to the event, so an accreditation can be produced. Please note that you may incur a wait for your accreditation if photos are not submitted prior to your arrival at the competition.

The Diving Team Briefing will take place at the Accreditation Desk upon each team's arrival. A team official will verify the name of the athletes and their participation, s/he will also verify the national flag and the national anthem.

VISA Information

The UAE Swimming Federation will provide an entry visa to the United Arab Emirates (UAE) for all the participants of the Diving World Series.

Visa requirements for entering UAE vary for different nationalities and it is always advised to check regulations before travelling. Currently, every nationality entering the UAE needs a visa except citizens of GCC countries (Gulf Cooperation Council: Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar and Saudi Arabia), expatriate residents of the GCC (certain nationalities and professions) and citizens from countries mentioned in the chart below.

Visa on Arrival

Other Nationals

All other nationalities can apply for an entry visa free of charge before entering the UAE by completing the Team Summary Form along with clear colored passport copy (.jpg form), passport photo and sending it by email to mail@uaeswimming.com. Please note that the passport needs to be valid for at least 6 (six) months from the date of entering UAE.

Visa applications will be accepted latest by **25 February 2012** and will be processed only for approved and accredited participants.

Judges

There will be seven (7) Judges at each DWS Event. The Individual Events will be scored in accordance with FINA Diving Rule D7.5 and D7.7.

In synchronised diving there shall be seven (7) judges – two (2) execution judges and five (5) synchronisation judges. The secretaries shall accept the "execution awards" and shall cancel the highest and lowest "synchronisation awards" and shall then calculate the score in accordance with FINA Diving Rule D7.7.

Prize Money

Each Event: The HMF/OC shall provide and pay prize money to a total of US\$ 96'000 at each Event to be divided between all of the 8 individual and synchro events, as follows:

1st place: US\$5'000

2nd place: US\$4'000

3rd place: US\$3'000

Sub-Total US\$12'000 Total x 8 events = US\$96'000

Overall: The HMF/OC shall pay US\$ 50'000 annually to FINA for each year of the DWS 2010-2013 to be put towards the overall prize money. The overall annual prize money shall be US\$192'000 to be divided between all of the 8 individual and synchro events, as follows:











1st place: US\$10'000

2nd place: US\$8'000

3rd place: US\$6'000

Sub-Total US\$24'000

Total x 8 events = US\$192'000

Hotel Accommodation

According to the FINA rules, each host country (United Arab Emirates, China, Russia & Mexico) shall provide full board accommodation (3 meals per day of adequate quantity and quality) for all qualified divers (minimum of 60) and 1 team leader/coach for each of the other DWS host countries (CHN, RUS, MEX) for a minimum of 5 days and 5 nights.

The official accommodation period will be as follows:

Arrival: 16.00 hrs Tuesday 13th March Departure: 15.00 hrs Sunday 18th March



Please note divers from the same federation who are of the same gender will be put into twin rooms. Reservations for additional nights accommodation can be made through the booking agencies, but you will be charged for these nights.

Grand Millennium

Boasting a central Dubai location on Sheikh Zayed Road, Grand Millennium Dubai offers spacious rooms. It has a rooftop swimming pool with panoramic city views. Free on site parking is available.

Rooms at the Dubai Grand Millennium have modern furnishings. Each room provides a bathrobe and slippers, a DVD player and flat-screen TV.













Grand Millennium features a range of restaurants and bars. The Asian restaurant on the 18th-floor has live cooking stations, and views of the Arabian Gulf and Jumeirah coastline. The pool-side bar offers light snacks and drinks.

Hotel Grand Millennium Dubai is located just a 10 minute drive from the Mall of the Emirates and Dubai Marina. Dubai Media City and Internet City are also just one mile from the hotel and Dubai International Airport is a 25-minute drive away.
